Seal pup washed up on beach at Baycliff. Historically it would seem to be SLDC who would remove but there is some uncertainty now as to who would be responsible. Cllr Willis to make enquiries.

- coastal erosion at bottom of Newbiggin and blue pipe is becoming more and more exposed. CCC have looked at this and plan to do necessary work but no timescale.
