- recent meeting held with WAF Engineer, Cllr Cooper & Cllrs Martin & Butler regarding the ramp access at Newbiggin. The PC understands that there won't be any further action taken by WAF Council unless there was a threat to the road. Resolved: To write to the Marine Management Organisation.
- flood at Baycliff on the high level bend is very dangerous. To report to HIMS.

10.To discuss Baycliff play area wall repair.

This has been looked at by Cllrs and full agreement that the repair is far from satisfactory – “the wall is leaning; not keyed into the rest of the wall; can just pull stones out/not fixed; disaster waiting to happen; not set firmly on the base and stones were removed with the repaired wall at a lower level than before. Resolved: To write to the insurer agent with photos to advise of this and request remedial action.

11.To receive updates re. playgrounds, and approve/ratify payments for Baycliff mower repair/Baycliff swing chain replacement & Scales swing cradle seat replacement.

To note receipt of Gleaston Village Hall & green committee payment for operational inspections.

Playground repairs made as follows:

Baycliff

- mower repair - £255.96 (incl VAT) (paid)

To pay:

- swing chain links - £137.84 (incl VAT)

- repairs as per inspection report - £264.76 (incl VAT)

Total - £402.60

All payments ratified & approved and PC to re-imburse BCA £402.60.

BCA to contribute £298.81 (total net amount less £250 from grant funds as approved at January meeting.)

- cradle seat – Playdale - £198.44 (incl VAT)

- springer suspension - Playdale - £127.20 (incl VAT)

SCA to contribute net amount of £271.37
